- We are modifying our student meal service plan from what I communicated last week in an effort to limit people having to be out. Starting tomorrow, Tuesday, March 24th, we will only have one pick up time. We will do a grab and go meal service on the south side of the elementary (outside the gym) from 11:30-1:00. We will provide that day's lunch and the next day's breakfast each day. We are continuing to work on a plan that could deliver meals as well. I will communicate that as we finalize the details.
- If you do not have internet service at home, People's Telephone has set up a public wireless network at our Elementary campus. You can park in the north parking lot and have internet access in your vehicle if you need it for your student to access online school work. I appreciate People's doing this for us.

This continues to be an ever changing situation we are encountering and I ask for your understanding and support as we go through this. Our board and our staff is dedicated to make sure that we keep your children safe. We are continuing to clean and sanitize every area of our district and encourage you to continue to follow the recommended steps to protect yourself and others.

- If you are a member of your household is sick, please stay home.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow.
- Wash your hands often and with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
